2. Current service or plans to serve the HVAC&R profession.
3. Demonstrated leadership ability.
4. Character attributes.

IMPORTANT: *The completed application, essay, and an **enrollment certification** must be submitted in one package and postmarked or emailed on or before the application deadline before your application can be considered. Submit only one application.*
